The college was established in the International Women's year 1975, by Thiru.A.D.Jeyaveerapandian, Thiru.A.D.Jawaharlalpandian, Thiru.A.D.Jeyempandian and Dr.Thiru.A.D.Jegadheeshwar (President), in the name of their parents A.Duraisamy Nadar MaragathavalliAmmal, for the benefit of a hundreds of generations of women folk in and around the coastal town of Nagapattinam.

The College has empowered generations of women, many of whom serve our nation with passion and commitment. The College is affiliated to Bharathidasan University and run by 'Natarajan Dhamayanthi Educational Society'.

The college takes pride in stating that it was awarded 'A' grade in its first accreditation in the year 2004 and it was Re-accredited with CGPA of 3.11 on four point scales at 'A' Grade during 2011 by NAAC. In the Year 2017 the College was Nationally Accredited with "A" Grade by NAAC with 3.28 in the III cycle. The college has been conferred Autonomous status for the first time during the year 2004. Extension of Autonomy was conferred on 24th September 2011 and in the year 2017 the Autonomous status was granted for the third time up to 2022. The vision of the Management, commitment of the faculty, creativity of the students, co-operation of parents and unstinted support of the society at large are the main impetus for the success of the college.

UGC has identified our college as a potential "Mentor Institution" to help the NAAC aspiring institutions from the academic year 2019 under Paramarsh scheme.
